

2013 Statistic Data of Persons Placed in Temporary Detention Isolators of the Human Rights Protection and Monitoring Main Division of the MIA

- Overall – 16536 persons are placed in Temporary Detention Isolators

Including:

- *14237 persons were taken to a court*
- *7152 persons were moved to a penitentiary institution*
- *734 persons were released by a judge*
- *1662 persons were released by an investigation*
- *374 persons were released due to the expiry of the term of their detention*
- *64 persons were moved to other institutions*
- *6618 persons were imposed an administrative punishment*
 - *1127 persons were imposed an administrative custody*
 - *4942 persons were imposed an administrative fine*
 - *549 persons were released, received a notice*
 - *criminal case under Article 273 of the Criminal Code of Georgia was initiated against - 1 person*
