Report of the Fourth Meeting

On December 25, 2014 fourth meeting of Interagency Coordinating Council for Combating Organized Crime was held at the Ministry of Internal Affairs of Georgia. The main subject of the meeting's agenda was the presentation of full report on the activities within the frames of the National Strategy for Combating Organized Crime. Based on the above, member bodies of the Council made short presentations of the activities held for 2013 – 2014 within the frames of the strategy.

Acting Chairman of Interagency Coordinating Council, Irakli Beraia, underlined the fact, that while elaborating and developing the action plan, also while implementation of the actions of the plan within the frames of thematic working groups, created by the Interagency Coordinating Council for Combating Organized Crime, more than 40 meetings were held, which were very productive and as a result, existing communication between the bodies of the Council was more enhanced.

Irakli Beraia also noted, that the action period of the action plan of the National Strategy for Combating Organized Crime is expiring in 2014. Therefore, it is necessary for interagency thematic working groups to work intensively to update abovementioned documents.

Irakli Beraia expressed his gratitude to the member agencies of the council once again and expressed hope, that the cooperation will be enhanced further within the frames of Interagency Cooperating Council of Combating Organized Crime.
