10-YEAR ACTION PLAN



CRIMINAL POLICE REFORM

▶ The complete separation of investigation, district and operative lines in territorial and structural units is underway and will be completed by 2025

▶ According to changes, police forces will completely undergo trainings and special material-technical equipment will be subjected to the thorough renovation

▶ By 2024, changes made to the Police Procedure Code will be fully enacted, enabling the complete separation of investigation and prosecution lines





COMMUNITY- ORIENTED POLICE ACTIVITIES



- ▶ **Community-oriented policing platform – Community Officers Institute was created**
- ▶ **A community-oriented policing strategy and relevant action plan were adopted**
- ▶ **At this stage, 279 community police officers operate in 3 districts of Tbilisi**
- ▶ **By 2023, Community Officers Institute will cover Tbilisi entirely and all large cities of the country, while by 2030, Community Officers will operate all across the country**

Human Rights Protection and Investigation Quality Department has been founded

Department's tasks include activities aimed at ensuring the quality investigation and timely response on crimes against women, domestic violence, crimes committed on the grounds of discrimination and intolerance, trafficking, crimes committed by or against juveniles



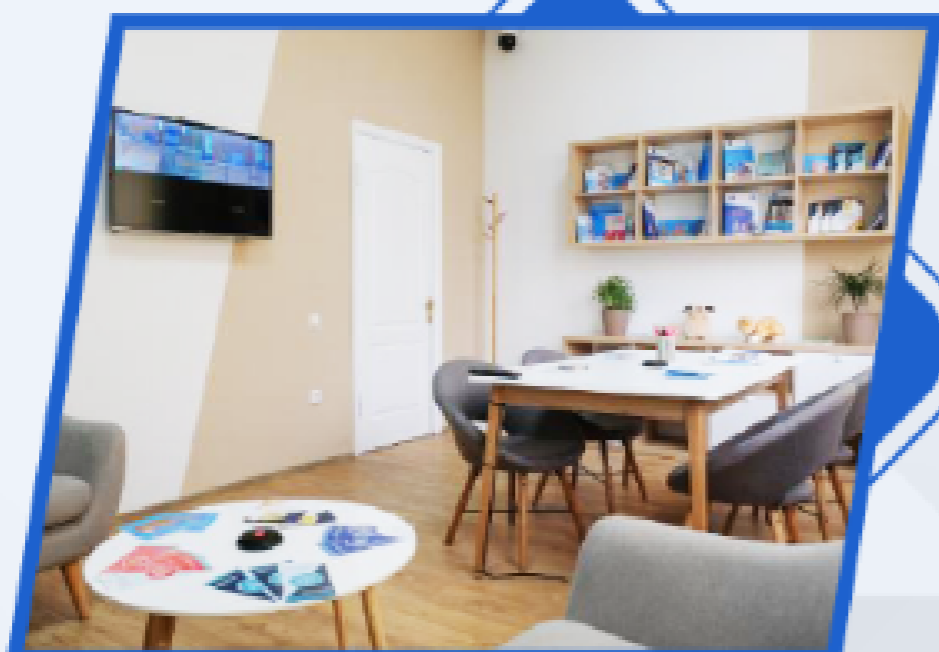
Main Division of Juvenile Affairs was created in Tbilisi, making relevant response on crimes committed by or against juveniles and cases launched under the Code of Administrative Offences

Similar divisions were also created in various territorial units as well



DEVELOPING MECHANISMS OF HUMAN RIGHTS PROTECTION

WITHIN TEN-YEAR PERIOD:



By 2023, child friendly spaces will be arranged in territorial units of Kutaisi and Batumi.

By 2026, the similar infrastructure will be provided in all large towns of the country

By 2024, the specialization procedures of investigators on sexual offences will be fully completed

By 2024, the Witness and Victim Coordination Service will be further enforced by adding 50 more employees, thus covering all police units across the country



CONTEMPORARY POLICE PROJECTS

WITHIN TEN-YEAR PERIOD:



ANALYSES-BASED POLICE ACTIVITIES

By 2025 analytical network will be available across the country



ELECTRONIC DISPATCHING

For proper and efficient allocation of police resources, with the aim of monitoring the operative response and activities of the personnel, the contemporary system of electronic dispatching is under construction, which also implies introduction of strategic and technical analyses unified system and depiction of analytical data



CRIME REPORTING APPLICATION

Will enable users to provide the Ministry with information on committed crime through various technical appliances openly or by preserving anonymity



CRIMINAL-INFORMATION MAP

Depiction of crimes, surveillance cameras, movement of patrol crews and strategic facilities on electronic map



CONTEMPORARY POLICE PROJECTS

WITHIN TEN-YEAR PERIOD



PLATFORM FOR MONITORING SEXUAL OFFENCE PREVENTION

will enable the full enforcement of the “Law on Combating Crimes against Sexual Freedom and Inviolability” in accordance of which personal files of convicts and persons deprived of certain rights will be administered and schools and orders will be monitored



SMART CAMERAS FOR IDENTIFICATION OF NON-ORDINARY BEHAVIOR

In case of depicting non-ordinary behavior or identifying fire shots by means of sound detectors, the information will be forwarded to relevant police unit



FACE/MOVEMENT RECOGNITION VIDEO SYSTEM

The possibility of identifying an individual by analyzing a photo, group photo or photo material fragments



DEVELOPING STATISTIC- ANALYTICAL PORTAL

Refinement of statistical module



PATROL POLICE DEPARTMENT



Personnel of border crossing points was fully equipped with new cameras, special police appliances and contemporary monitoring equipment



In order to increase the border management effectiveness, special emphasis will be made on introduction of border risk analyses unified system



PATROL POLICE DEPARTMENT



UNIFIED SERVICE CENTER

- ▶ At the Unified Service Center of the Patrol Police Department citizens are provided with relevant police services on the basis of a “single window” concept
- ▶ In order to further increase the accessibility of services, Unified Service Centers will be opened in all large cities of the country



TRAFFIC SAFETY



5293 cameras are linked to the unified network, out of which **1775** operate on plate number recognition, while **3518** on general vision



295 speed sections have already been put into operation based on which **1269** km area is being controlled

WITHIN TEN-YEAR PERIOD AND EXISTED BUDGET:



300 cameras will be installed each year



50 speed control sections will be put into operation



TRAFFIC SAFETY

WITHIN TEN-YEAR PERIOD



All border crossing points, cities and highways will be completely covered up to 13 000 smart, general vision and face recognition cameras



Service infrastructure required for video cameras and radars will be fully renovated



PUBLIC SAFETY COMMAND CENTER – 112



With the merger of 112 and Joint Operations Center, Public Safety Command Center – 112 was established

At 112 service video call services were introduced for deaf and hearing impaired citizens, in case of emergency they are able to contact 112 by means of video call or SMS



112 mobile application was also created, enabling to establish the exact location. The important features of the application include: silent alert message (SOS) and correspondence with operator

Electronic monitoring of the abusers has been initiated, which is technically performed by Public Safety Command Center – 112





PUBLIC SAFETY COMMAND CENTER – 112

WITHIN TEN-YEAR PERIOD:

PROQA

With the introduction of Priority Dispatch program (PROQA) the service level of 112 will be improved and response timeframe shortened



Early warning SMS system will be introduced by means of which citizens on dangerous territories will be warned on the existing or imminent threats



Software for processing the “Voice Bank” collected by 112 through calls will be introduced



SERVICE AGENCY

WITHIN TEN-YEAR PERIOD:



Vehicle registration on distance will be introduced from 2022 as well as replacement of the state number plates



Beginning from 2022 the practical tests for driver's license will be held in two stages, implying testing the future drivers in real traffic conditions



Moped registration will be implemented and exams will be mandatory



BORDER PROTECTION

- ▶ **Border operations electronic monitoring system has been arranged in 9 border sectors**
- ▶ **Shipyard facility in Poti fully renovated and equipped**
- ▶ **New building of Joint Maritime Operations Center has been built**
- ▶ **Batumi base station - small sized ship dock built for Coast Guard Department**
- ▶ **Coast Guard radio communication systems fully renovated**

BORDER PROTECTION

- ▶ Coast Guard Department received two Island-class patrol boats from the United States
- ▶ Two boarding teams of the Coast Guard Department and two vessels got involved in The Operational Capability Concept Evaluation and Feedback Program (OCC E&F)





BORDER PROTECTION

WITHIN TEN-YEAR PERIOD:



All border sectors will be fully renovated



State border will be fully equipped with contemporary border monitoring technical means



Coast Guard fleet will be strengthened



EMERGENCY SITUATIONS MANAGEMENT SERVICE

- ▶ Material-technical base of Emergency Situations Management Service has been significantly improved
- ▶ Fire-rescue facilities constructed in 12 cities in line with contemporary standards
- ▶ Naval unit of Emergency Situations Management Service was provided vessels of various modifications
- ▶ Emergency Situations Management Service was provided 30 units of “Iveco Magirus” special transport means





EMERGENCY SITUATIONS MANAGEMENT SERVICE

WITHIN TEN-YEAR PERIOD:



The number of facilities under the supervision will be increased



Risk and emergency situations management plans will be elaborated



Itemizing of interactive maps



150 fire-recue points will be constructed/ renovated



TEMPORARY PLACEMENT ISOLATORS



- ▶ From 2012 all Temporary Placement Isolators have been equipped with video surveillance cameras
- ▶ From 2016 Medical units were created at Temporary Placement Isolators
- ▶ New building in line with contemporary standards was built and put into operation

WITHIN 10-YEAR PERIOD:

- ▶ Infrastructure renovation activities will be implemented in all isolators



MIGRATION DEPARTMENT



- ▶ Migration Department was created in 2014
- ▶ Center for temporary accommodation of migrants without legal grounds has been built in Georgia

WITHIN 10-YEAR PERIOD:

- ▶ Infrastructure rehabilitation of temporary accommodation spaces of migrants as well as construction works and material-technical equipment activities



INTERNATIONAL POLICE COOPERATION



- ▶ The Center of International Police Cooperation in the Law Enforcement Sphere was founded
- ▶ The network of police attaches has been further enforced
 - In 2012- 4 police attaches covered 4 countries
 - In 2021- 16 police attaches cover 24 countries as well as Europol and NATO

WITHIN 10-YEAR PERIOD:

- ▶ The network of police attaches and liaison officers will be further enhanced
- ▶ Specializing and capacity building of police employees will be held on the regular basis



FORENSIC-CRIMINALISTICS DEPARTMENT

- ▶ New administrative building of Forensic-Criminalistics Department was built and equipped, where 20 forensic-medical laboratories are located
- ▶ Laboratories of Forensic-Criminalistics Department have been certified under ISO international standards
- ▶ Forensic-Criminalistics Department became the member of European Network of Forensic Science Institutes (ENFSI)





FORENSIC-CRIMINALISTICS DEPARTMENT



WITHIN 10-YEAR PERIOD:

- ▶ The capacity building of DNA, ballistics, fingerprint and chemical, biological, radiological and nuclear profile laboratories will be further enhanced.
- ▶ The sphere of Ballistics and chemical expertise standard accreditation will be further enhanced
- ▶ The action plan for the operation of chemical, biological, radiological, nuclear and dangerous chemical substance laboratories will be elaborated



ACADEMY OF THE MINISTRY OF INTERNAL AFFAIRS



Special educational program for basic training was introduced at the Academy



New space for fire-tactical training space was created

Special space for simulation trainings were founded



WITHIN 10-YEAR PERIOD:

- ▶ Police professional studies will be provided on the regular basis under the programs in line with international standards
- ▶ Capacity building of personnel will be further enhanced in coordination with foreign law enforcement agencies



SOCIAL GUARANTEES AND PROJECTS

- ▶ From March 1, 2013, monthly bonus payments were introduced for employees of the Ministry
- ▶ From 2014, one-time material assistance is allocated for the employees of the Ministry in case of child birth, marriage, and death of a family member
- ▶ From 2015, the families of policemen who died in the line of duty receive one-time financial assistance in the amount of 100 000 GEL
- ▶ The Ministry also provides medical insurance for all employees and family members
- ▶ Salary of employees is increased gradually on the regular basis

WITHIN 10-YEAR PERIOD:

- ▶ The growth of salaries are scheduled to be implemented periodically

WIDE SCALE INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS

WITHIN 10-YEAR PERIOD

THE FOLLOWING BUILDINGS WILL BE RENOVATED:

- ▶ 185 police buildings
- ▶ 14 border sectors
- ▶ 60 points for Emergency Situations Management Service
- ▶ 24 Temporary Detention Isolators
- ▶ 18 Forensic buildings
- ▶ 15 Patrol Police buildings
- ▶ 13 facilities for Special Tasks Department



WIDE SCALE INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS

WITHIN 10-YEAR PERIOD THE FOLLOWING BUILDINGS WILL BE BUILT:

▶ 30 police buildings

▶ 20 facilities of Border Police

▶ 90 points for Emergency Situations Management Service

▶ 2 Temporary Detention Isolators

▶ The building of Forensic-Criminalistics Department

▶ 2 facilities of Special Tasks Department

▶ Building of MIA archives

▶ Building of Migration Department



PURCHASE AND THOROUGH RENOVATION OF VEHICLES

WITHIN 10-YEAR PERIOD:

- ▶ Besides the purchase of vehicles within the frames of annual budget, the police vehicle fleet will be renewed and replenished
- ▶ Emergency Situations Management Service will be provided with vehicles and various types of rescue technic, including: more than 400 fire-fighting trucks with various specifics, 40 motorized boats and 2 fire-rescue vessels
- ▶ All helicopters owned by the Border Police will undergo modernization and complete repair works. Sub-units will be provided with new transport means
- ▶ Two helicopters are also planned to be purchased for the Border Police



ARMAMENT/ SPECIAL MEANS/ COMMUNICATIONS



Outdated armament and special means will be fully renovated



Unit radio communications will be fully renewed, which will increase the capacity of police effectiveness



IMPROVING THE LEGAL FRAMEWORK



In 2013 Police Ethics Code was adopted



New “Law on Police” was enacted in 2014 in line with human rights protection standards

WITHIN 10-YEAR PERIOD:



Reform of operative-search legal framework will be implemented



Standard police procedure will be elaborated in full compliance of international standards on police activities
