It is significantly important that the international community today stands together to put an end to such evil as terrorism. The Barcelona tragedy is yet another signal, that we all must take firm action to stop this brutality. As the incident serves as a stark reminder of the fragility of life it is extremely importance to stand persistent in our pursuit of a better and more compassionate world.

We stand with the Government of the Kingdom of Spain in the fight against terror with all existing instruments available to us.

At the same time, we strongly believe that nothing can impede aspiration of the Spanish people toward freedom, safety and sustainable development.
