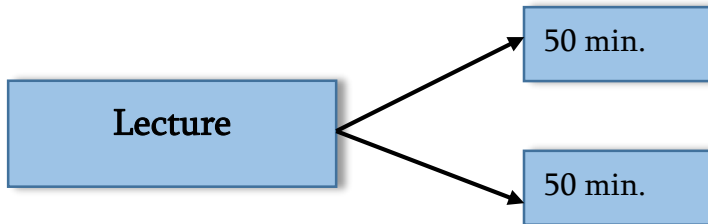


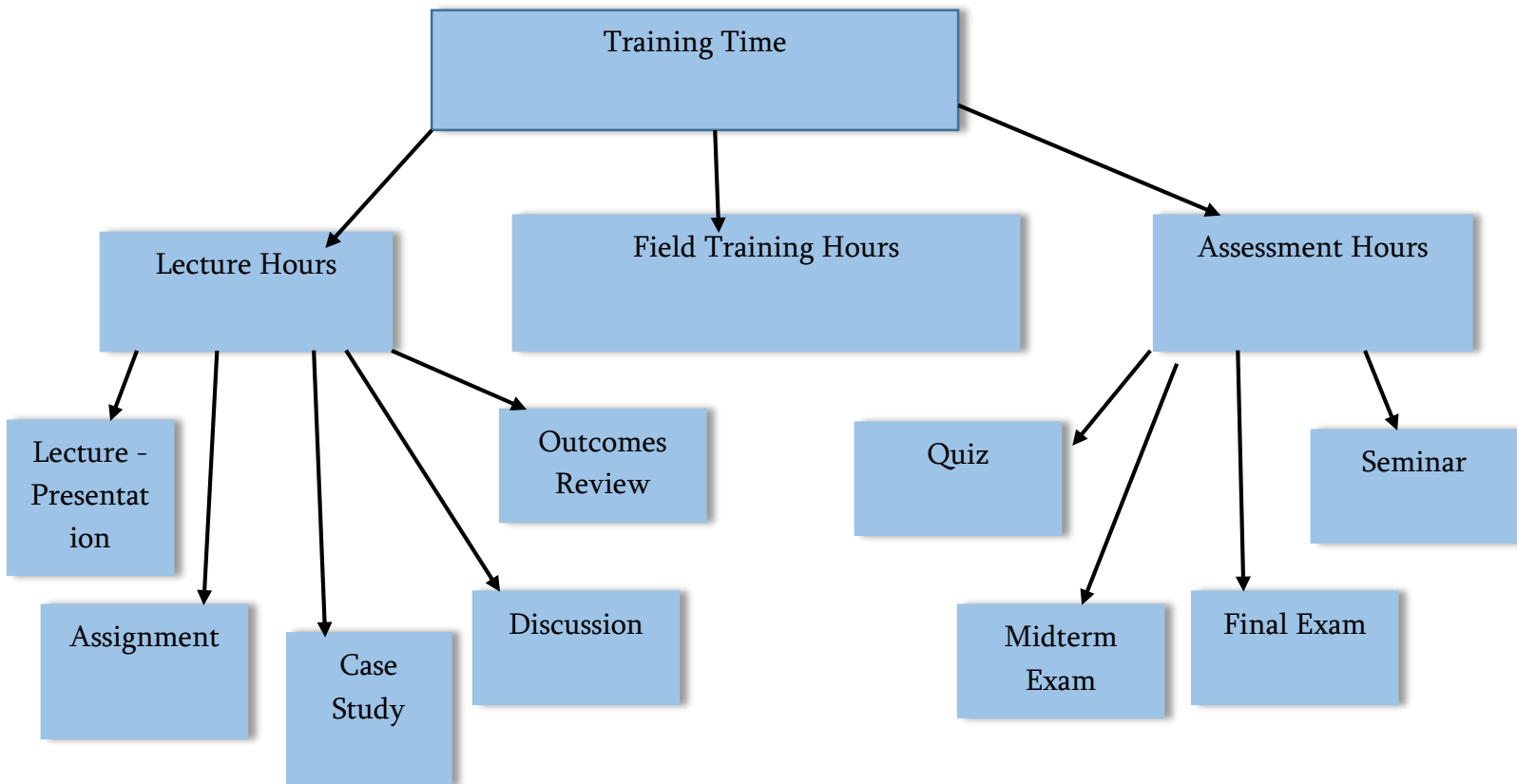
## Training Methodology

The maximum number of students in training groups is 25, while the minimum is 5. The training duration doesn't exceed 6 academic hours a day at the Academy.

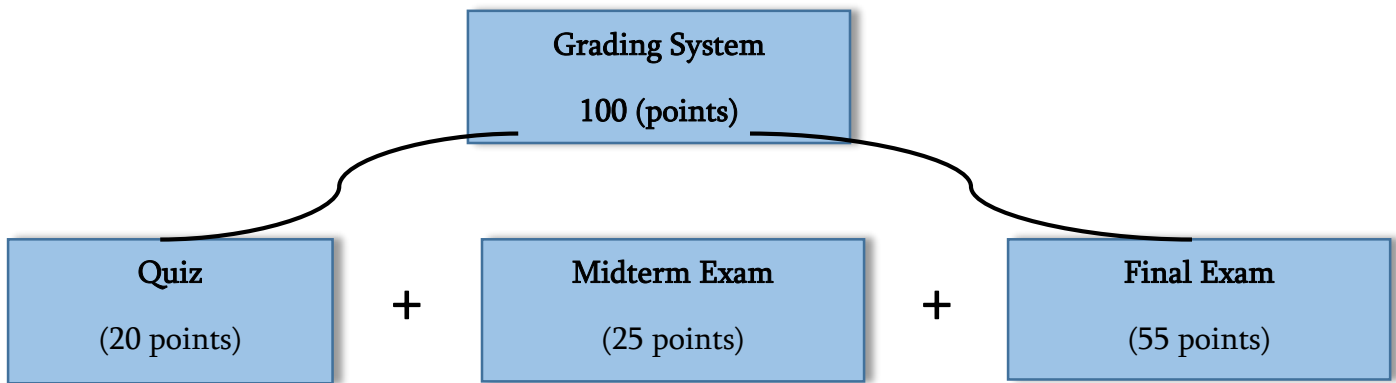
One lecture/practice hour consists of two academic hours. (1 acad. hr. = 50 min.)



Lecture/practice hours are conducted with 10-minute intervals and one 30-minute break.



At the Academy 100-point grading system comprises the following components:



**Quiz** - Periodic assessment of the materials covered during the previous lectures.

**Midterm Exam** - Assessment of a student's knowledge level after covering 50% of each course included in a training module.

**Final Exam** - Assessment tool evaluating a student's knowledge regarding the respective module.

A student won't be admitted to the final exam if s/he has accumulated less than 15 points by that time (quiz + midterm exam);

A student should get at least 25 points for passing the final exam.

The minimum requirement for passing a training course/module is 51 points in total;

In case of scoring less than 25 points in the final exam or failing to pass the minimum requirement (51 points) established for the training course/module, a student is allowed to take the final exam once more if s/he has total 40 points or more (quiz + midterm exam + final exam).

The certificate with honours is awarded if the average grade of all the training courses/modules included in the program is 90 points or more.
